Award recognizes companies that have excelled in helping utilities in other service territories restore power after similar storms and other natural events.

A restoration crew of more than 1,800 workers assembled throughout Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire and proceeded with restoration efforts despite harsh conditions, which included wind gusts of 45 miles per hour. After completing its work, the CL&P crew was redirected to assist both WMECO and PSNH. Seventy-five percent of affected customers were brought back on line after five days, and service was restored to all customers after 13 days.

The company also provided crucial assistance to one of its fellow utility companies this past year, after Hurricane Ike delivered the most devastating winds in Ohio's history, with gusts reaching speeds of 84 miles per hour. The wind was enough to cause major damage to the distribution and

transmission infrastructure, and knocked out power to 300,000 DP&L customers.

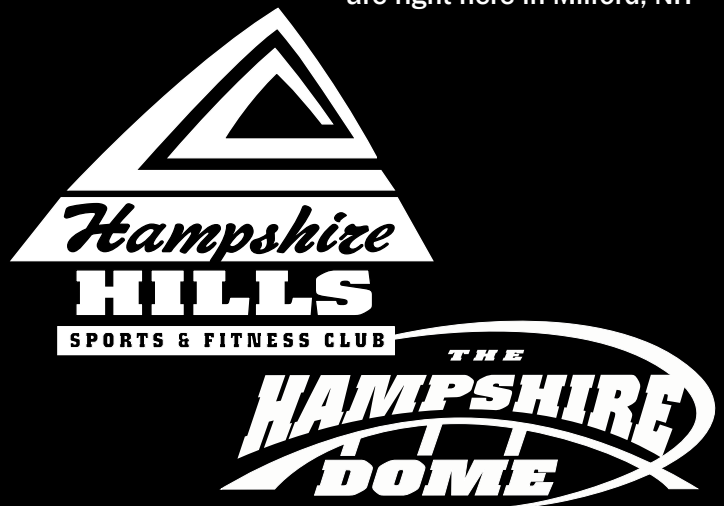

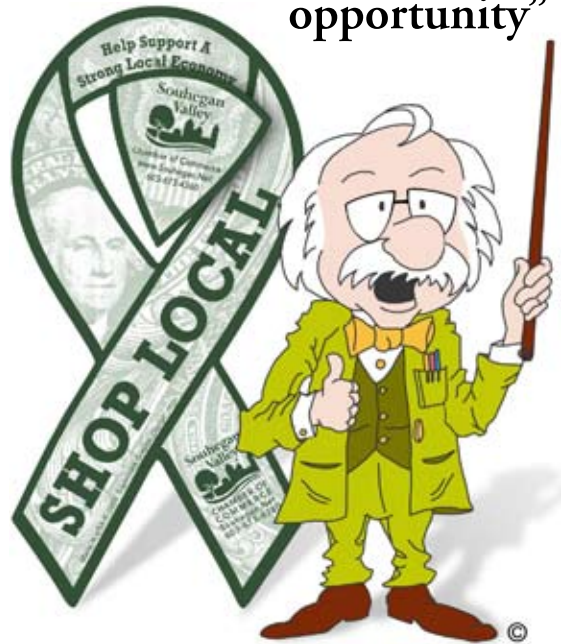

ROTARY GROUP STUDY EXCHANGE PHILIPPINES

Amherst branch manager, Amy Wheeler, recently returned from a 40-day community service project tour in the Philippines. Amy was one of four individuals selected from the NH/VT Rotary district 7870 to go on a Rotary Foundation Group Study Exchange trip to the Eastern Visayas island region of the Philippines. While there Amy and her GSE team spent time observing and helping Filipino Rotary projects on the island provinces of Samar, Leyte, Cebu, Negros Oriental, Siquijor, Bohol and Mindanao.

Many of the Filipino Rotary projects target the impoverished population in their communities by providing bamboo and neepa housing to the homeless; dry toilets to villages (baranguays) that have no plumbing; medical supplies and beds to local hospitals; dental, eye and general medical care to the ill; birthing supplies to expecting mothers; food to the hungry; books and basic supplies to the schools and college scholarships to graduating seniors.

One of Amy's favorite Rotary projects in the Philippines was a public elementary school feeding project in Ormoc, Leyte.

"There is no such thing as a hot-lunch

program or even a cafeteria in many of these public schools. They are open air buildings with little more than a rooftop and supporting walls. They have no electricity and conduct classes during natural day light. Many of the children come from impoverished families with many siblings and attend class on a hungry stomach.

The two local Rotary Clubs of Ormoc City identified there was a need to help and developed an ongoing feeding program. In speaking with the teachers they discovered that Fridays have the lowest attendance of students because many of the young children are forced by their families to skip school and work in the rice fields earning between 1 and 2 US dollar equivalents. By introducing a hot-lunch program on Fridays, attendance of these students increased dramatically; keeping them in school, out of the rice fields and well nourished. The Ormoc Rotary clubs enlisted the help of mothers to cook and prepare the food while they supplied the ingredients.

The Rotarians weigh each student at the beginning of the year and follow their growth progress throughout the year, adding more feedings per week if any children continue to be underweight and show signs



of malnourishment. The feeding program is simple and basic yet so essential to bettering the lives of these children and it's all thanks to the volunteerism and commitment of the Rotary.

I will never forget my time in Ormoc schools participating in the feeding programs. It has left a permanent mark on my heart that I will carry throughout my life."
