Scheduling these programs is our part. Taking advantage of one or more and getting some new connections or new ideas - that is your part.

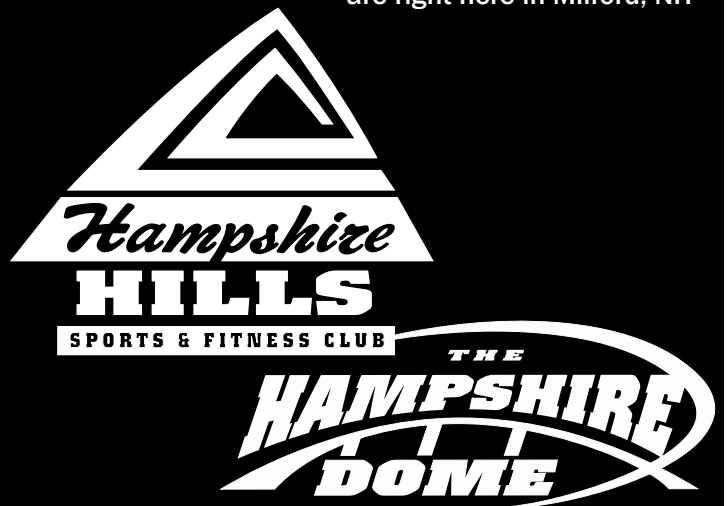

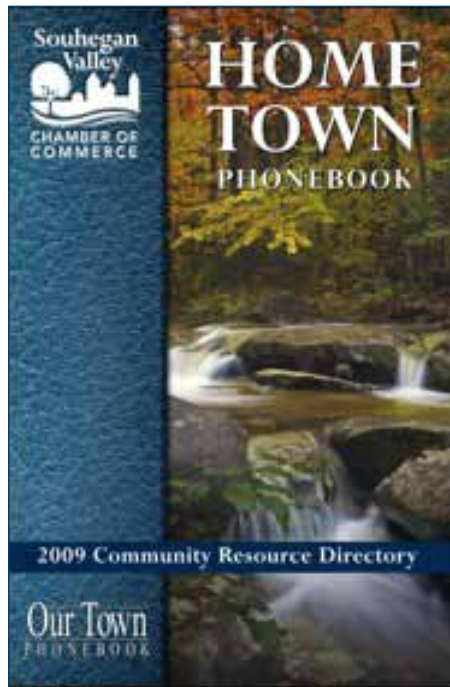
