Beaver Brook Association (BBA), with support from local community and conservation organizations, has embarked on a campaign to purchase nearly 80 acres of land contiguous to its 1,850 acres of conservation land in Hollis and Brookline, NH. The land is located off of Rocky Pond Road abutting BBA's northern most land.

BBA's goal is to raise \$650,000 by the March 2010 deadline to cover the purchase price of \$600,000 and associated costs, including the placement of a conservation easement on the property. The property was appraised at \$850,000. The organization has raised over \$400,000 to date in private donations and public support from the Hollis Conservation Commission.

"This is Beaver Brook Association's largest land purchase in 35 years," says Cliff Simmonds, Beaver Brook's Executive Director "And it's the first time in our 45 year history that we are asking for public assistance to purchase conservation land."
